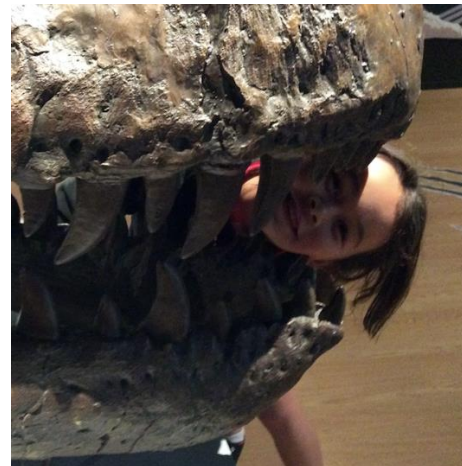
Duffy Books - \$5 parent offer
