Another way to have fun with Maths! (Materials: A pack of playing cards without the King, Queen and Jack)

Make 10 To make a total of 10.

1. Shuffle the cards
2. Make 2 rows of five, cards facing up.
3. Player one starts, picks up cards to make 10,
Picks up 3 + 7
4. The cards are replaced from the pile. (6 and 10)
5. Player two takes their turn. Picks up 10, 10 + 0 = 10
6. The card is replaced from the pile. (6)
7. Player one turn. (6 + 4)



The winner is the player with the most cards. After a while encourage your child to pick up more than two cards.
