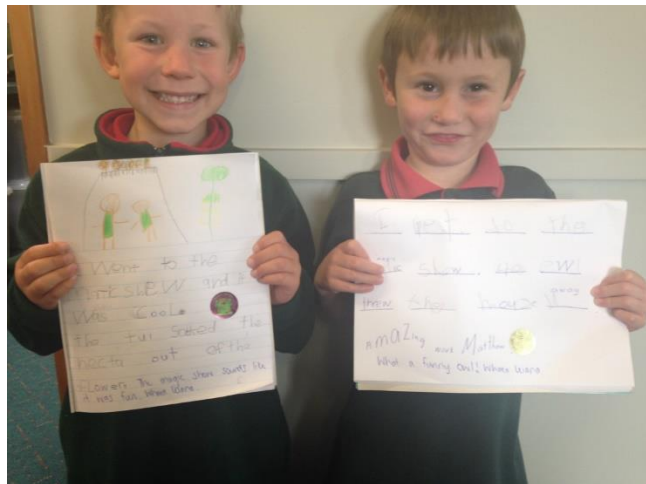
Building work in Room 9 and 10
