Smencils Fundraiser

PB4L update (Positive Behaviour for learning)

We are making huge progress in developing the evidenced based approaches within the school. We have our **LEGEND** box up and running from next week and staff will be catching students who are displaying the **LEGEND values** in the playground. We have also started developing our characters for each value. At Cloverlea School, we teach what is expected. If students are having difficulty asking how to play in a game, we teach. If students are struggling with *'resiliency'* when they get 'out' in a game, we will be teaching the students strategies. This is developing over time as we focus on strengthening the systems we have in place and identifying what we can do better.
