CLOVERLEA SCHOOL ENROLMENT SCHEME 2022

The Ballot for Term 1 2022 is now closed.

Enrolment at Cloverlea School is governed by an enrolment scheme, details of which are available from the school office. Parents of students who live within the home zone and **intend enrolling their child at any time during the next year** should notify the school as soon as possible to assist the school to plan appropriately for next year.

Out of Zone Students

The board has determined that up to 32 New Entrant and Year 1 places are likely to be available for out-of-zone students in Priorities 2-5 for the next year. The exact number of places will depend on the number of applications received from students who live within the school's home zone. For 2022 there will also be 2 spaces for Year 2 students, 6 spaces for Year 3, and 1 space for Year 4 students. There are no spaces available for Year 5-6 for 2022.

If the number of out of zone applications exceeds the number of places available, students will be selected by ballot. If a ballot for out-of-zone places is required, it will be held on the below dates. Parents will be informed of the outcome of the ballot within three school days of the ballot being held.
