HEAD LICE

Recently we have been made aware of a growing lice problem within some classes here at Cloverlea School.

Check: Check your child's hair regularly - once a week is a good guide.

Treat: If you find live lice or unhatched eggs, treat your child as soon as you can.

Head lice are common in children, with regular monitoring we can easily keep the outbreaks to a minimum. We also have Lice Shampoo and combs available in the office area at School that are free to parents and their children, just ask at reception and remember to check weekly!
