ROAD SAFETY MESSAGE

We have been Rae Pakari (Determined) to get some important road safety messages out to all our **LEGENDs** and whānau to help make our roads safer before and after kura. You might have seen the Excellent (Kairangi) video on Facebook last week. Classes are all watching this with their kaiako in class. All **LEGENDs** are practising crossing safely with our road patrollers and identifying where the yellow lines are that are not safe to park on.

Thank you for showing Ārahi (Lead) by helping your **LEGENDs** to use the crossing, even when you are walking them across the road.

Thank you for showing Kotahitanga (iNclusive) by parking away from the yellow lines. Our road patrollers need you to follow the rules so that they can do their job safely.

Please be aware that over the next while the Police will be helping keep all our **LEGENDs** safe and issuing tickets for any parking issues.
