Rūma Whitu showed rae pakari (determination) in completing their stingray mahi toi as part of our pāngarau (maths) measuring mahi. We began by reading the pukapuka *How Māui Fished Up the North Island*, retold by Donovan Bixley, to inspire our work. Using a stingray template, we carefully traced the shape onto cardboard, stuffed it with tissue, and secured it with tape before beginning the paper mache process. Once dry, we let our creativity shine, painting over the textured surface to bring our stingrays to life..We can't wait to dive deeper into our learning about stingrays. Ka pai, Rūma Whitu!
