## CLOVERLEA SCHOOL BALLOT

Enrolment at Cloverlea School is governed by an enrolment scheme, details of which are available from the school office. Parents of students who live within the home zone and **intend enrolling their child at any time during the next year** should notify the school by as soon as possible to assist the school to plan appropriately for next year.

### Out of Zone Students

The board has determined that up to Thirty-two New Entrant and Year 1 places are likely to be available for out-of-zone students in Priorities 2-5 for the next year. The exact number of places will depend on the number of applications received from students who live within the school's home zone.

There are also: 3 spaces in Year 3, 3 spaces in Year 4, 2 spaces in Year 5. There are no spaces in Year 2 and Year 6.

In 2024 there will be **four** enrolment periods as set out below

If the number of out of zone applications exceeds the number of places available, students will be selected by ballot. If a ballot for out-of-zone places is required, it will be held on the below dates. Parents will be informed of the outcome of the ballot within three school days of the ballot being held.

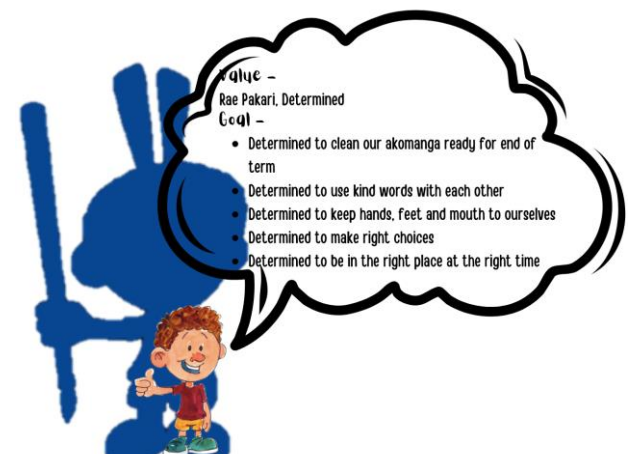
