Last week Room 1 started Geometry for mathematics, looking at 2D and 3D shapes. We explored isometric dot paper and learnt to draw 3D cubes, rectangular prisms, triangular prisms and pyramids. To extend ourselves we then learnt to combine these shapes to create 3D drawings of houses.
