**Road Safety Before and After School:** we have had several staff come to Senior Leaders concerned about safety at our crossings before and after school. Please be **Determined** not to stop or park on yellow lines or over gateways so our year 6 Road Patrol **LEGENDs** have clear vision and can make good choices. Safety of all our **LEGENDs** is our top priority.

Police are visiting local schools and giving reminders about what we should do to keep our students and community safe. They have told us that we should:

- Advertise in our school newsletter that we will be taking action to deal with illegal parking in order to ensure our students and community are safe.
- Talk to our students and have them remind their parents not to park illegally.
- Have teachers warn parents who are parking illegally and keep a record of warnings.
- If a parent has been warned and we need Police to take action by issuing a \$60 parking ticket email with the details.

We do not want to have to do this, and we are hoping this **iNclusive** reminder is enough. Thank you for making sure our school is safe.
