FLIPPED LEARNING

Cloverlea staff LEGENDs have completed in-depth professional development to ensure our practice is Excellent! Flipped learning allows teachers more time to build positive learning relationships with their LEGENDs and dig deeper into learning.

At Cloverlea School we use a flipped learning approach to teaching and learning. In flipped learning, LEGENDs watch a short video that teaches key skills and/or knowledge prior to working with their kaiako. The flipped learning approach is supported by sound research showing it improves learner engagement and achievement.

Flipped learning means LEGENDs can pause, rewind and replay as often as they need to until they understand the concept.

After watching the video, time with the kaiako is used to support, reinforce and apply new learning, and extend them further.

Flipped learning videos are all made by our Cloverlea kaiako for our LEGENDs.



Flipped learning is iNclusive as LEGENDs are able to work at their own level and pace.

Cloverlea School has digital 'libraries' of videos in each learning area that are tailored to LEGENDs individual needs.
