To help your leadership teams and whānau plan ahead, we have finalised our enrolment and transition timeline. Here are the key dates regarding the Monrad Tirohanga enrolment process:

Monday, 20th April (Week 1, Term 2): Enrolments officially open for 2027.

Tuesday, 28th July & Wednesday, 29th July (Week 2, Term 3): The Monrad Tirohanga Roadshow will be visiting your schools.

Wednesday, 5th August (Week 3, Term 3): Open Night for prospective whānau begins at 6:00 pm.

Wednesday, 16th September (Week 9, Term 3): Tono Hui for whānau applying for our Tahuna-ā-Rua (Māori Medium) pathway.

Monday, 23rd November (Week 7, Term 4): Orientation Day for our confirmed enrolments in 2027.
