In the holidays, Whaea Mia and I attended a conference in Australia - listening to indigenous education leaders from Australia and New Zealand. We had been asked to run a workshop around the process with Te Wheke, and how as a school, we have developed our curriculum around local and national places and history. We could see some real clear alignment around what we are currently experiencing in education with what is happening in Australia while also considering how we navigate Aī.
