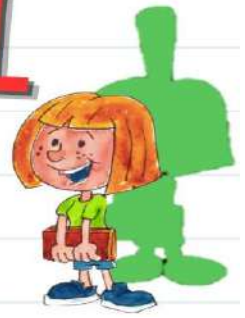

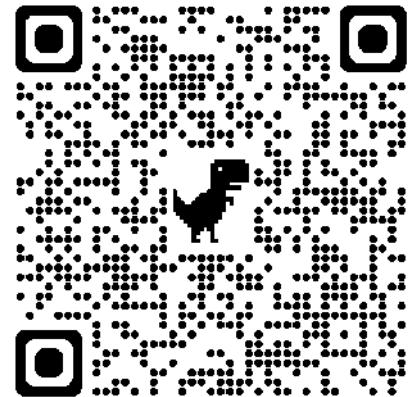


PRINCIPAL'S PEN
