Thank you to all our whānau who are supporting our **LEGENDs** with understanding how to cross safely. When you model using the crossing, it means your **LEGEND** will be safe as they get older and are more independent. You will see our Year 6 **LEGENDs** outside in the cold, the wet and on hot days in summer being 'iNclusive' and making sure they are keeping everyone safe. RUAHINE TEAM

As part of our kaupapa this term, the senior team has been exploring Te Ahu a Turanga. Our focus has been on the Manu Ngaro sculpture, using it as a starting point to learn about the extinct birds of Aotearoa and the importance of protecting our natural environment. To connect our learning with another sculpture, Hinetiawaiwa, our **LEGENDs** have created woven bird artworks. These pieces combine our kaupapa into learning about the colour wheel, extinct birds with the traditional art of weaving.
